

Environmental Policy Statement

An Environmental Management System (EMS) has been developed and implemented at Eastgate Shopping Centre, covering the management and operation of the centre, in accordance with the requirements established in the international standard – ISO14001:2015. This policy statement documents the core principles and operating conditions of the EMS.

Eastgate Shopping Centre is committed to continual improvement of the EMS to enhance environmental performance, pollution prevention and protection of the environment. Objectives are established on an annual basis with monitoring and review completed regularly to ensure appropriate progression.

Objectives aim to address the following key areas which are considered the highest risk associated with environmental management at Eastgate Shopping Centre:

- Improvement of waste management with a focus on waste minimisation
- Improvement of energy efficiency within centre buildings
- Improvement of awareness and understanding of environmental issues amongst employees, contractors, tenants and visitors.

Eastgate Shopping Centre is committed to fulfilment of compliance obligations (which include requirements prescribed by investors in the centre).

This document will be communicated and explained to all employees and staff working at Eastgate Shopping Centre. It will also be displayed at appropriate locations around the centre and will be freely available to the public.

This policy will be regularly monitored and, if necessary, revised in consideration of legislative or organisational changes.
